

UCSI HAS GIVEN OUT MORE THAN RM2.3M IN SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

Continuing a tradition of celebrating excellence in academic, UCSI has given out scholarships and awards worth approximately RM2,370,000 at its Awards Day ceremony held on 13th September 2006.



Awards Day is held every year to reward UCSI students who excel in both academic and extra-curricular activities. There are three categories of academic-related awards: the President's Award, Overall Achievement Award and Dean's List Award.
