

Samy Vellu's Deepavali Open House At PWTC on Oct 21

Works Minister Datuk Seri S. Samy Vellu will host a Deepavali open house at the Putra World Trade Centre (PWTC) on Saturday.

He said the open house has to be held at the PWTC as the hall in his house could not accommodate the 6,000-odd guests.

He said his open house would be from 7pm to 10pm out of respect for the Muslims who will be fasting in the day.

"All Muslims are invited to break fast at the open house," he told reporters after giving out Deepavali and Hari Raya goodies to about 1,200 Indians and Malays there.

Samy Vellu, who is also MIC president and Sungai Siput Member of Parliament, said giving out alms and gifts during festive seasons could unify the multi-racial Malaysian society.

He wished Selamat Hari Raya Aidilfitri to Muslims and Happy Deepavali to the Hindus in the country.
