I used to take a Metro bus at 6am from Subang Jaya to Kota Raya, and from the STAR LRT station at Plaza Raya, take the LRT to Bandar Tasik Selatan Station, before boarding the RapidKL bus to UCSI. Where the bus stops, it's still a long walk away to UCSI. Now, it's so easy. I take the 7.30am KTM Komuter and transit at KL Sentral reaching Bandar Tasik Selatan at 8.30am, and hop on the shuttle service.

I take the 8am LRT from Bandar Tun Razak to Bandar Tasik Selatan. Before the shuttle service was introduced, it was difficult to get to UCSI. I have to wait for RapidKL (Route 401). It is not regular – a bus every one-hour and it stops at the bus stop on the opposite side of the highway.

I park my car at Kepong KTM station and take a 30-minute ride on the Komuter to Bandar Tasik Selatan. On days when there are heavy traffic jams along Jalan Kuching and Jalan Cheras, I reach home on time. I can only look back at those people caught in the traffic jam, and smile. Thanks to the shuttle service, I stopped driving to office since taking KTM Komuter two months ago. No more parking woes for me and I save at least RM150 a month on petrol. Good enough for a dinner with friends.

From Subang Jaya, I take the KTM Komuter and change lines at KL Sentral. Monday, May 15, was the first time I tried out the shuttle service. Before this, I used to drive to office every day. Petrol was about RM600 every month including the toll. Now, with the shuttle, it costs me about RM240 a month.
