

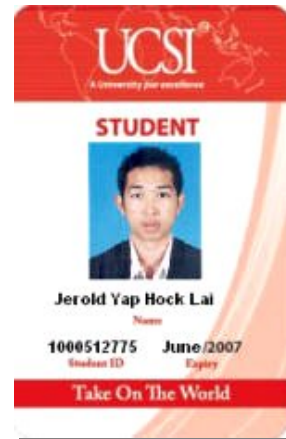
The UCSI Smart Card

What's there for me?

Dear Students,

We are pleased to announce that the new UCSI Smart Card is now available. This new smart card will include several optional services in addition to being the University's photo identification card. The new card will feature options such as main gate and building access, van shuttle service, car park services and the availability to purchase meals at the cafeteria. These features will be introduced in phases between now and the end of the year.

The new smart card will continue to be used in the same manner as the old PVC card but will now offer capabilities of several cards in one. First and foremost, the new smart card will serve as the official UCSI identification photo card and it will continue to allow students access to other University services such as examination tokens, attendance, building and laboratory access, Student Council voting and other campus events.



The **Student Affairs Office** and the **University Registry and Examinations Department** will be helping you in acquiring the new UCSI Smart Card. With effect from **Thursday, 11 May 2006**, you will be able to sign up for your new UCSI Smart Card at the **lobby area of Menara Gading (Block A)** until further notice.

Please be reminded that you should change your UCSI ID to the new UCSI Smart Card at the earliest opportunity to avoid any last minute rush or untoward incidences. Only a maximum of 300 applications will be entertained per day.
