

AGREEMENT SIGNED WITH TESDEC

KUALA TERENGGANU, 4 December 2006 Monday –UCSI announced today that it has signed an agreement with Terengganu Skills Development Center (TESDEC) to purchase a 16-acre land, located in Bukit Kor, Marang, to further expand its current development of a new medical campus.

The campus, which will be named the UCSI Terengganu Campus, is the first full-fledged private university set up in the educational hub of Terengganu. “The establishment of our state-of-the-art UCSI campus in Marang is indeed a benchmark project by a private university in the beautiful state of Terengganu,” said Ng. “It is also indeed very much in keeping with the Terengganu State Government’s slogan, “Heritage Land, Education and Innovation”.

Together with UCSI’s current 40-acre of land, this purpose-built campus will be ready by May 2007. “We also plan to eventually introduce other health-related

degree programmes such as Optometry and Dentistry to make our Terengganu campus an institution fully dedicated to healthcare,” added Ng.

Tan Sri Datuk Seri Panglima Abdul Rahman Arshad witnessed the signing ceremony between the Chairman of Terengganu’s Education, Science and Technology and Human Resource Development Committee, Y.B. Dato’ Dr. Abdul Latiff bin Awang and President & Vice Chancellor of UCSI, Peter T.S Ng.
