TAN SRI AHMAD RAZALI MERIT SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS WORTH RM2 MILLION launched

KUALA LUMPUR, 14 February 2007 - University College Sedaya International (UCSI) today launched the **Tan Sri Ahmad Razali Merit Scholarship Awards** worth RM2 million in conjunction with the official launch of Dewan Tan Sri Ahmad Razali. This hall, which can seat 1,200, will be used for important functions and examination purposes.

According to UCSI's President and Vice Chancellor, Peter T. S. Ng, the scholarship which will be awarded annually is a gesture to honour the former Menteri Besar of Selangor, Allahyarham Tan Sri Dato' Seri Haji Ahmad Razali bin Haji Mohd. Ali.

"Tan Sri's contributions towards our development as a college are invaluable," he said. "As a person, Tan Sri was both a mentor and a friend to me."

The late Tan Sri was described as one who was "perseverant and passionate," who remained committed and was instrumental in laying the foundations for the then- Sedaya College to grow into Sedaya International College and, today, University College Sedaya International.

"It is our gesture to preserve the legacy of the man himself," said the Vice Chancellor, in his tribute to the late Tan Sri Ahmad Razali who was also UCSI's Chairman of the Board of Governors from 1998 until his demise in 2001.

UCSI's Chancellor, Tan Sri Datuk Seri Panglima Dr. Abdul Rahman Arshad also paid tribute to the tireless efforts of the late Tan Sri Ahmad Razali. "We believe it is timely that we honour a man who served his king, country, and fellowmen with passion, commitment and integrity," he said.
